

## Exemplary Schedule for First Semester BA Students

In the American Studies BA program, there is generally no fixed structure determining when to take which courses. However, there are a few constraints you should keep in mind when creating a schedule for your first semester. Students enrolled in a BA American Studies must have acquired 20 LP out of the obligatory courses in the base modules by the end of the second semester, including:

- 3 of the 4 introductory courses *and*
- General Language Course A

Based on these constraints, this is what your schedule could look like:
